

Background

Component 4: Strengthen Capacities of other LGU's and Partners

to Address Environmental Issues

The Local Government Academy was identified and tasked by the DILG to manage the GO FAR / L-EPM Component 2. This component primarily focuses on the creation of a center of EPM Studies in Mindanao. This Center shall be the repository of knowledge on EPM Process and Projects in Mindanao. The Center shall facilitate organizing the Local Resource Institutes in Mindanao to share knowledge and technologies as well as design new tools, curricula, and projects concerning L-EPM.
